2. The posts mentioned at the serial number 1 to 6 and 12 to 15 shall be part of the respective State cadres. Recruitment to these posts and posting of the persons shall be done, according to respective cadre rules.

3. The sanctioned posts of Havildar (Sl. No.7) and Constable (Sl. No.8) shall constitute the respective cadres of the 3rd India Reserve Battalion. This shall mean that the persons recruited against these posts can not be transferred out to any other Battalion. They may, however, be deputed under extreme compassionate circumstances to another battalion only once in their career for a period not exceeding 3 years.

4. Recruitment to the posts of Constables shall be direct from the open market observing the Government approved eligibility criterion and the manner of selection. Recruitment for the posts of Havildar shall be by promotion of the eligible and suitable Constables of the same Battalion. The Government approved eligibility criterion and the manner of selection shall be applicable for selection of Constables for their promotions to the rank of Havildar.


5. The posts at serial number 16,17, & 18 (Medical Staff) of the table above shall be filled up on contractual and consolidated remuneration as applicable to Medical Officers under Health and Family Welfare Department.

6. The post at serial number 19 to 23 (Menial Staff) of the table above shall be filled up on contractual and consolidated remuneration of Rs.2500/-p.m.

7. The charge is debitible to Demand No.I-2055-Police-104-Special Police-0683- India Reserve Battalion in the Budget Estimate for 2007-08.

8. This has been concurred by the Finance Department in their UOR No.169/G.S.I dated 20.03.2007.






