11	Brief of incident	Laxmikanta Jani, Ex Commando-51 of SOG, Chandaka was sent in an Anti-Maoist operation to M. Ramour in Kandhamal District. He was the team leader of Team No-4 during the operation. After completion of operation the team proceeded towards the pick-up point near Khamankhol on 4.6.2017. The operational team were picked-up from village Khamankhol and started returning back to Phulbani via Barakhama. However, during the return journey, the last vehicle bearing no OD-15-G 2594 was ambushed by the Maoists at Khanjalagu Ghat. The Maoists triggered a landmine and fired indiscriminately on the Commandos. Who fought valiantly and were successful in breaking the ambush. However, Laxmikanta Jani was severely injured in the cross firing and succumbed to injuries while shifting to hospital. He thus, sacrificed his life while fighting in the line of duty.
