05	Brief of Work Done :- <u>Operation Muskan-II by Crime Branch, Odisha.</u> Operation Muskan-II has been quite successful as 2610 missing children have been rescued in the process. Out this, 2271 are boys and 339 are girls. The rescued children shall be put up before Child Welfare Committee and appropriate steps will be taken for restoration of the children to their family for reunion. A month long dedicated campaign was launched on 25th July to 24th August, 2016 for rescue and rehabilitation of missing children inside and outside the State. During phase I of Operation Muskan-II, 2417 missing children including 274 minor girls were rescued from within the State. Phase II Operation Muskan commenced from 10th August and continued up to 25th August for rescuing children from outside the State. Ten Police teams including officials of the Department of women and child Development were formed and sent to different States to rescue the missing children. Team Odisha rescued highest number of missing children from Tamilnadu, Kerla, Telengana, Chhatishgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, West Bengal, Karnatak, Delhi, Maharastra, UP and Gujarat.
