RESOLUTION

Dated, Bhubaneswar, the 18.3.2021

Sub: Revision of Special Operational Incentive to police personnel appointed on contractual basis and posted / deployed in Special Operations Group

No.HOME-DA1-SANC1-0002-2020/ 11657 /D&A, The proposal for revision of Special Operational Incentive in favour of Constables / Sepoys appointed on contractual basis in terms of 'Odisha Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules 2013' and posted / deployed in Special Operations Group (SOG) was under consideration of Government for quite some time.

2. After careful consideration, Government has been pleased to enhance the quantum of existing Special Operational Incentive from 60% of Basic Pay (*extended vide this Department's Resolution No. 33211/D&A dated 20-09-2016*) to Rs. 15,500/- per month in favour of contractual Constables / Sepoys deployed in SOG for anti-Naxal operations.

Further, the nomenclature of the said Incentive is now revised to 'Special Operational Incentive'.

3. In line with afore-mentioned decision, Government has also been pleased to extend 'Special Operational Incentive' of Rs. 23,400/- per month in favour of contractual Sub-Inspectors / Sergeants / Deputy Subedars, appointed under Odisha Group 'B' posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules 2013 and deployed in SOG for anti-Naxal operations.

4. The afore-said Special Operational Incentive is admissible only for the period for which they are posted in field during their deployment in SOG for anti-naxal operations.

5. This has been concurred in by Finance Department in OSWAS file FIN-CS2-ALW-0001-2019.
