Setting up of one unit of Orissa Disaster Rescue Assistance Force (O.D.R.A.F.) at Balasore ----- creation of one Platoon of A.P.R. Force thereof.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the Governor to the creation of one Platoon of A.P.R. Force consisting of the 44 posts of various grades as detailed below to be stationed at Balasore in the district of Balasore for setting up of one unit of Orissa Disaster Rescue Assistance Force (O.D.R.A.F.). The scale of pay shall be as noted against each with usual D. A. & other Allowances as sanctioned by the Government from time to time. The dates of creation of the Posts shall be the dates those are filled up.

2. The posts at Serial 6 and 7 of above table shall be filled up on contract basis at a Consolidated monthly remuneration of Rs.2500/- per month. Only surplus staff of the Government nominated by the A. R. Cell of General Administration Department shall be considered for such appointment. The draft of the Contract Agreement to be executed is enclosed. First appointment shall be offered for two years and thereafter renewed for a period of not exceeding two years at a time subject to the condition suitability and good conduct of the persons concerned.

3. The incumbent to aforesaid posts will form a part of the District A.P.R., Balasore and shall function under the full control of Superintendent of Police, Balasore. But they shall be instantly available to Special Relief Commissioner in full strength as an ODRAF Unit for deployment any where in the State.

4. When not deployed in disaster rescue work, the Unit may be engaged for police duty as decided by the S. P., Balasore but without adversely affecting its utility and deployability as an ODRAF Unit.

5. The charge is debitable to the grant under the head "Demand No.1 - 2055 - Police - Non-plan- 109 - District Police - 0003050 - District Organisation" (voted) in the Budget Estimate for 2004-2005.

6. This has been concurred in by Finance Department in their UOR No.4 GS-I, dated 06.01.2004.
