


Ratha Yatra at Puri is the largest congregation of pilgrims in Odisha. More than three million people throng the holy city in a period of twelve days. An elaborate Police arrangement was put in place for smooth conduct of the car festival involving more than seven thousand police personnel. 140 platoons of force, 2 companies of Rapid Action Force, 2 companies of Odisha Swift Action Force (OSAF), 2 units of Special Operation Group (SOG), 2 units of Odisha Disaster Rapid Action Force (ODRAF), 2 units of STU, one unit of NDRF, 212 AET Trainees were deployed during the 12 day long festival. 13 SsP/Commandants, 27 Addl. S.P/ DCs, 85 D.SsP, 88 Inspectors, 604 CSIs, 90 Havildars, 445 Constables and 2000 Home Guards were engaged for this mega annual event.

Training Programmes and Workshops



State Crime Branch organized a two day training programme on "Cyber Crime Investigation, Intelligence and Surveillance" at Police Bhawan, Bhubaneswar on 10th and 11th July, 2018. Dr R.P. Sharma, DGP was the Chief Guest on the occasion and inaugurated the programme. Sh Santosh Upadhaya, ADGP Crime, Sh Arun Bothra, IGP CID, CB, Sh Himanshu Lal, DIGP (STF), Sh Rajesh Pandit, former SP, CID, CB and Sh. Koraput Police organized a special sensitization workshop for school children at Jeypore on the online game Momo challenge, the cyber bullying game, responsible for a spate of suicides among children on the 7th September, 2018. The children during the workshop were advised to limit their use of smart phones and computers. The guardians were also asked to install parental control software on computers and mobile phones used by children. The rebel's mother, suffering from high blood pressure and haemoglobin deficiency, was rushed to Kalimela Community Health centre by IIC Kalimela. Police also purchased required medicines as per prescription of the doctor. Randev had joined rebel out-fit in 2004. Presently, he is the Divisional committee Member of Kalimela Dalam. His mother lives in Badatekguda village.





GRP Constable saves man's life

GRP Constable Balaram Singh of Odisha Police played the role of good samaritan by rescuing a man who fell unconscious due to heart attack at platform no-1 in Bhubaneswar Railway Station. On hearing the news, Singh who was off duty rushed to the spot and found a passenger lying unconscious near the foot over bridge. Wasting no time, Constable



Singh started Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) therapy. He performed chest compression, massaging of hands and artificial respiration (mouth-to-mouth resuscitation). After 10 to 15 minutes, the passenger became stable and shifted to hospital in an ambulance. The valuable life of a man was saved due to the timely action of Balaram.
