Guidelines regarding posting of Police personnel in Marine Police Stations.

The Government of Odisha has implemented Coastal Security Scheme since 2005 in two phases. Under Coastal Security Scheme (CSS) Phase I & II all together 18 Marine Police Stations have been made operational / functional in seven Coastal Districts.

In order to streamline the functioning of Marine Police Stations, to ensure proper utilisation of training and capabilities of police personnel posted in Marine Police Stations and to ensure specialisation, following guidelines are hereby issued.

- Constables and Havildars posted to Marine Police Stations shall continue for a period of 7 (seven) years. Such Constables and Havildars shall not be transferred before 7 (seven) years to Non-Marine Police Stations except on administrative ground with approval of ADGP, Coastal Security. They may however be transferred from one Marine Police Station to another Marine Police Station within the district. This will come into effect from last October 2020.
- Sub Inspector of Police & Assistant Sub Inspector of Police who are 2. posted to Marine Police Stations shall normally continue for a period of 3 (three) years. Approval of ADGP Coastal Security will be required for premature transfer, before completing three years.
