POLICE ORDER No. 283/86

The Regional State Forensic Science Laboratory, Sambalpur has started functioning since 1st December 1986 and for the present it will serve the police districts of Sambalpur and Sundargarh for expert examination of exhibits. The laboratory is in a position to undertake the following examinations:

- 1. Examination of fire-arms, amminition and related exhibits
- 2. Physical examination and matching of cloth fragments, broken articles, wires including telegraphic wires.
- 3. Chemical examination of liquor, Bhang, Ganja and opium
- 4. Chemical fanalysis of alloys, metals including spurious gold and other precious metals
- 5. Examination of blood and blood stains, seminal stains and determination of their origin and grouping.

All exhibits necessitating the above examination and relating to the police districts of Sambalpur and Sundargarh should be sent to the Deputy Director, Regional Forensic Science Laboratory, Ainthapalli, P. O. Budharaja, Sambalpur for examination and report.

The method and procedure of collection, packing and transportation of exhibits are the same as those laid down in Police Order No. 174.

Such exhibits from the two districts of Sambalpur and Sundargarh should not be referred to State F. S. L., Rasulgarh, Bhubaneswar.
