Deogarh Police launched “Prakalpa Swabhiman” for women victims of violence

Deogarh Police launched “Prakalpa Swabhiman” in the District on 1.6.2016. In the project women in distress and women victims of violence were formally enrolled in different vocational training courses in Rural Self Employment Training Institute (RSETI) Deogarh. Around 302 victims registered their names to undergo training in different trades. S.P Deogarh Smt. Sara Sharma, ADM Deogarh Dr. Bhakta Ch. Pradhan, PD DRDA Sri A.Kerketta, District Welfare Officer, Director OLM, GM DIC, LDM, Lead Bank attended the meeting to enlighten the victims about the various avenues available to them. The idea was mooted and came to fruition due to the efforts of Deogarh Police. Around 500 women from the remotest areas and Naxal infested belt of Deogarh District attended this programme. They were asked to pick up skill and become self-reliant through the programme. This programme happened to be the first of its kind in the State where women victims of violence were enrolled en-mass for vocational training.
