

## STATE LEVEL CONFERENCE OF WOMEN POLICE PRESS RELEASE

- A one day State Level Conference of 'Women in Police' was held in the Conference Hall of 6<sup>th</sup> OSAP Bn, Cuttack on 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2020.
- 2. 127 'Police Women' of all ranks of Odisha Police participated in the Conference and deliberated on various gender specific service and welfare issues of Women Police personnel of Odisha Police and suggested solutions to the issues deliberated for consideration of the State Police Head Quarters. The delegates comprised of 4 IPS officers of the rank of ASP to IGP, one SP, 3 Addl SP, 12 DSP, 12 DSP(I/C), 29 Inspectors, 17 SI, 8 ASI, 2 Havildar, 3 Lance Naik, and 48 Constables.
