BRIEF NOTE ON OPERATION MUSKAN BY CRIME BRANCH, ODISHA

In accordance with orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court all States and union territories were requested by Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India to take part in a dedicated campaign titled "Operation Muskan" to rescue and rehabilitate missing children. In Odisha the operation was launched in two phases. During first phase from 1st to 12th July a campaign was launched to trace missing children within the State. In the second phase from 30th July onwards teams were sent to various States and important cities to trace and rescue missing children of Odisha.
